Learning Outcomes	This course focuses on the design of pedagogical programs for special populations, at the different areas and contexts where this knowledge is required - (a) lifelong psychomotor reabilitation and atypical human development; (b) social integration, accessibility, and new technologies and; (c) promotion of personal and social skills.
Syllabus	The topics are organized and structured around two centres of interest, corresponding to the themes within the concept of curricular development: (a) Curricular Theory; (b) Planning – the techniques and approaches of an organizational process, regarding pre-interactive decisions and corresponding products (the plans).
Evaluation	Continuous assessment: (a) two tests and; (b) a project work in groups. c) Participations and presences in the theoretical an practical classes. The final assessment is the mean of these three tasks. Students must attend a minimum of 2/3 of the lecture-practicals classes.
